Your vehicle deep clean checklist

Starting at the driver's seat, disinfect the:

- ✓ Steering wheel (horn, steering wheel controls)
- ✓ Ignition
- ✓ Rearview mirror
- ✓ Visor
- ✓ Air vents
- ✓ Dashboard
- ✓ Seatbelt, seat and adjustment handles

Move on to the middle section of the front, disinfect the:

- ✓ Infotainment system
- ✓ Heating controls
- ✓ Air vents
- ✓ Radio controls
- ✓ Centre console
- ✓ Gear stick
- ✓ Handbrake

On to the passenger's seat, disinfect the:

- ✓ Dashboard area
- ✓ Glove box
- ✓ Air vents
- ✓ Visor
- ✓ Seatbelt, seat and adjustment handles

For cars, move on to the back, disinfecting the:

- ✓ Seats and seatbelts
- ✓ Back of middle console, including vents
- ✓ Pull-down arm rest and storage compartment
- ✓ Boot space, including surface area, storage pockets, floor tab

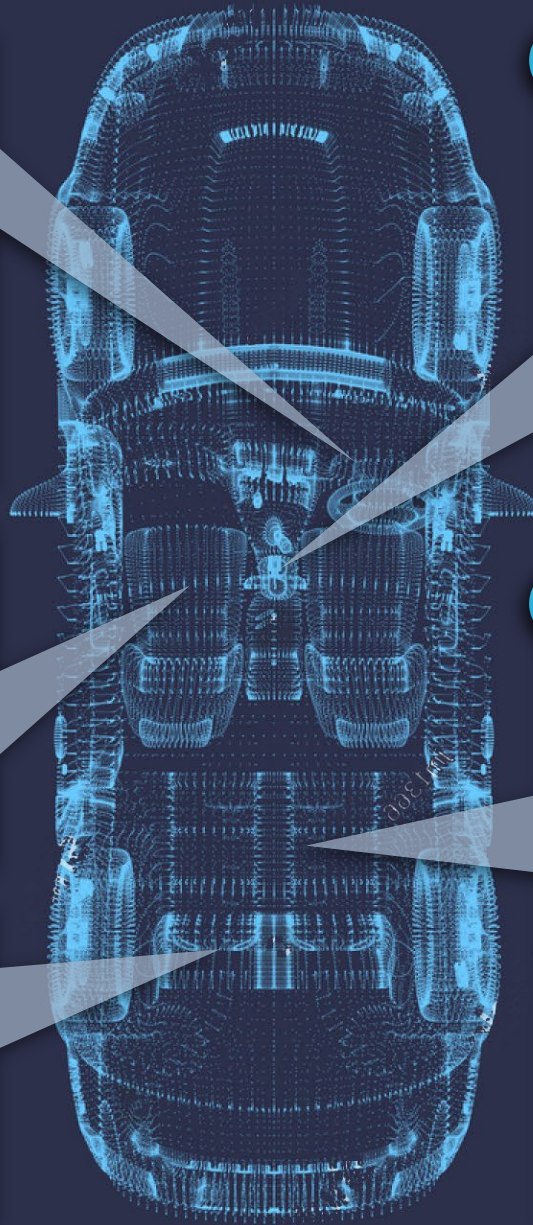

Other:

- ✓ Doors, door handles and door pockets
- ✓ Window controls
- ✓ Grab handles
- ✓ Floor
- ✓ Roof

For vans, disinfect the:

- ✓ Interior of van, including roof, doors, floor and walls, any internal storage units



- ✓ Remove protective gear and dispose of the items, along with the used cloths, wipes or kitchen roll, in a bin liner. Double bag items and store securely for 72 hours before fully throwing them away.
- ✓ Remove all clothing and put them in the wash at a high temperature setting to kill any lingering germs.
- ✓ After this is done, make sure to wash your hands thoroughly for at least 20 seconds.
- ✓ Repeat deep-clean on a weekly basis or daily, if you are working with a partner.
